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as the first world war reaches its final year an illicit love affair is beginning between a sixteen year old boy and a young woman married to a soldier at the front they meet secretly in her flat on the outskirts of paris in cornfields and on river banks when she receives letters from her husband they burn them together intoxicated by passion they cannot bear to end their affair even when it causes a scandal among their friends and neighbours instead they hurtle towards tragedy written in spare haunting prose when raymond radiguet was still a teenager this semi autobiographical novel became an instant bestseller and its author was hailed as a genius before his tragic death at the age of twenty expressing all the anguish and joy of adolescence it is a work of startling imagery and subtle beauty translated by robert baldick with an introduction by fay weldon

the history of cinema and notably that of post war italian cinema can only be understood adequately in the context of other contiguous cultural disciplines world literature including that of france germany and russia played a key role in the development of post war italian film and the cinematic technique it has come to embody moving away from the usual modes of defining this period a trajectory that begins with neorealism and ends with bertolucci author carlo testa offers proof that coming to terms with literary texts is an essential step toward understanding the motion pictures they influenced the means of recreating literature for the screen has changed drastically over the last half century as has the impact of different national traditions on italian cinema testa s work is the first to explicitly and deliberately link postwar italian cinema to general intellectual concerns such as the relationship between literary authors and cinematic auteurs moreover his analysis of the impact of french german and russian cultures on italy brings forth a new reading of italian cinema a new paradigm for exploring complex issues of authorship culture and art

puberty is a time of tumultuous transition from childhood to adulthood activated by rapid physical changes hormonal development and explosive activity of neurons this book explores puberty through the parent teenager relationship as a normal state of crisis lasting several years and with the teenager oscillating between childlike tendencies and their desire to become an adult the more parents succeed in recognizing and experiencing these new challenges as an integral ineluctable emotional transformative process the more they can allow their children to become independent in addition parents who can also see this crisis as a chance for their own further development will be ultimately enriched by this painful process they can face up to their own aging as they take leave of youth with its myriad possibilities accepting and working through a newfound rivalry with their sexually mature children thus experiencing a process of maturity which in turn can set an example for their children this book is based on rich clinical observations from international settings unique within the field and there is an emphasis placed by the author on the role of the body in self awareness identity crises and gender construction it will be of great interest to psychoanalysts

caresse crosby rejected the culturally prescribed roles for women of her era and background in search of an independent creative and socially responsible life poet memoirist advocate of women s rights and the peace movement crosby published and promoted modern writers and artists such as hart crane dorothy parker salvador dalí and romare bearden she also earned a place in the world of fashion by patenting one of the earliest versions of the brassiere behind her public success was a chaotic life three marriages two divorces the suicide of her husband harry crosby strained relationships with her children and legal

confrontations over efforts to establish a center for world peace as the first biographer to consider both the literary and social contexts of crosby's life linda hamalian details crosby's professional accomplishments and her personal struggles the cramoisy queen a life of caresse crosby also measures the impact of small presses on modernist literature and draws connections between key writers and artists of the era in addition to securing a place for crosby in modern literary and cultural history the cramoisy queen a life of caresse crosby contributes to the field of textual studies specifically the complexities of integrating autobiography and correspondence into biography enhanced by thirty two illustrations the volume appeals to a wide range of readers including literary critics cultural historians biographers and gender studies specialists

there is never a shortage of priest characters on our screens even spencer tracy bing crosby and barry fitzgerald won oscars for playing priests robert de niro has been ordained four times including a bishop many stars have been eager to play priests as have numerous supporting actors the question arises how have been priests portrayed over the decades there have been kindly priests with their advice stern priests who laid down the law heroic priests on mission in more recent years priests who have been abusers and there have been priests who were part of the scenery especially at funerals this is something of a comprehensive look at priests on screen looking at portrayals from the late 19th century over the decades for 120 years the films considered are mainly english language but quite there are a number from other cultures the book offers some church background and developments the range of films a highlighting of a

key film representing each decade it also has separate chapters on irish priests australian priests exorcism priests and a chapter on films and abuse there also appendices on historical films saint priests and popes while one could read the book from cover to cover it is mainly a book for reference there are some detailed appreciations there are some shorter considerations not everyone can see every film not for want of trying there are indexes for exploring film titles directors and actors who have played priests screen priests is a fascinating historical look at films about roman catholic priests from the first until martin scorseses 2016 religious and cinematic masterpiece silence with the scope spanning decades and the breadth embracing films mostly from the united states britain ireland canada and australia the researcher will find a treasure trove and the film aficionado will relish peter malones encyclopedia knowledge and sometimes trivia of the world of priests on the silver screen

this is the first comprehensive bibliography on american author kay boyle the political active boyle was one of the so called lost generation of american expatriate writers in europe between the world wars she traveled in the literary circles of james joyce ernest hemingway and gertrude stein she wrote fourteen novels nine short story collections three children s books five collections of poetry and two collections of essays additionally she ghostwrote two books co edited two others and translated three books from french into english the gifted writer was awarded two guggenheim fellowships and was a member of the american academy of art the academy recognized boyle for her extraordinary contribution to contemporary american literature over a lifetime of creative work

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
